



## NSGA Scholarship

NSGA Scholarship Goal; to invest in the future of the Ontario Nursery Sod Industry through education and training.

### Scholarship Value

\$750.00

### Eligibility:

To be eligible the applicant must be a current NSGA member or from the immediate family (child, sibling, spouse) or employee of a current NSGA Member.

### Area of Study and Course Start Date:

Area of study is open but must be applicable to the sod industry or sod operation.

Course start date will be the 6 months before or after December 31<sup>st</sup>. (For example the 2011 NSGA Scholarship will be for course starting dates between June 1, 2010 and May 31<sup>th</sup> 2011.)

Proof of course completion will be required at the end of the course.

### Timeframes:

Application deadline is December 31<sup>st</sup>.

Scholarship recipient will be chosen by January 31<sup>st</sup>.

Announcement and award presentation will be made at the AGM (March).
